The dream of an International Training Center for unionized masonry craftworkers has become a reality today on a 25-acre site in Bowie, Maryland.

Officially opened in September 2007, the state-of-the-art complex features:

- Training classes offered for all level of BAC members, from pre-job apprentices to superintendents, in all the crafts: brick, tile, stone, marble, terrazzo, cement, plaster, and PCC/restoration.
- A 61,000 square-foot, two-story open bay training center with offices, classrooms and design studios.
- A 46,000 square-foot main building with offices, recreation facilities, cafeteria, meeting rooms, and dormitory rooms to accommodate 108 students.
- Both buildings are constructed of high quality masonry materials, representing all BAC crafts.
- The John J. Flynn BAC/IMI International Training Center is the permanent home of IMI's Masonry Camp – the premier program that brings together young architects and apprentices for a unique exchange of ideas and skills.
